Meet the Staff:

Director: Wendell Hannaford

Wendell has been coaching soccer at multiple levels for over 10 years. He spent 3 seasons as the Assistant and Goalkeeper coach for the Albright college Men's and Women's Soccer programs. He has been a head coach of U15 and older teams with Penn Legacy Soccer Club since 2011 as well as coaching the club's goalkeepers. Wendell has been on the EPYSA ODP staff since 2015 working with the U12 and U13 Boys and Girls in the Lancaster area. In his playing days, he helped lead the Albright Lions to the first playoff appearance in over 30 years. He was named Commonwealth Conference Goalkeeper of the week twice, was a member of the All-Conference team in 2007, and still holds the All-time school records for career shutouts and lowest goals against average. Wendell holds the NSCAA Goalkeeper diploma, as well as multiple USSF and NSCAA coaching diplomas/certificates.

Assistant Director: Steve Moore

Steve has been coaching soccer since 2000. Coaching every age group from U6-U19 with LYSC. He joined the WHS staff in 2016 as the JV head coach. Steve's playing career started in the early 2000s at the age of 30 something, playing in the Wick O30 summer league in Lititz. He recently has played with the Wick O40 amateur team. He is a graduate of Warwick High School. Steve holds a USSF E license and multiple NSCAA diplomas.

Assistant Director: Maria Tivoli

Maria has been coaching for the past 4 years. She has been an assistant coach with Penn Legacy since 2014. She has been involved with HS girls' soccer since 2013. She has coach both JV and Varsity levels at Manheim Township High School, Lampeter Strasburg High School and now Warwick High School. As a player, Maria was a member of Manheim Township High 2009 team of Section 1 Champs, LL League Champs and District 3 Champs, the programs only District 3 Championship in school's history. She then played 4 years at Neumann University for the women's soccer program. Of her 4 years playing, the team made the playoff seasons 3 times, the first in program's history in 2010. She was a member of the 2nd Team All-Conference in 2009, Honorable Mention in 2011 and 1st Team All-Conference in 2012. Maria holds a USSF E License.

Assistant Director: Jason Harris

Jason joined the Warwick Girls coaching staff as a volunteer in the fall of 2016. He has been coaching youth soccer since 2005. In 2008, Jason began coaching a LYSC travel team that he has coached the past 9 years. Jason moved from Norfolk, VA to Lititz 20 years ago. Prior coaching soccer, Jason played college baseball at Old Dominion University in Norfolk, Va. While taking coaching courses, Jason began playing as adult for an adult league. He currently holds a NSCAA regional coaching license.

INCLEMENT WEATHER POLICY: We do not cancel camp due to rain; however, we do take into consideration field conditions, age groups involved, forecast and the threat of thunder and lightning. If camp is canceled prior to the start of camp, all players will be notified. If camp is already in progress, all field activities will cease immediately if thunder and lightning storms are in the area. All attempts will be made to hold camps as scheduled. In the event of a heavy, prolonged downpour and/or lightning, the players will move from the fields to a covered area. If the rain persists, campers are to be picked up from camp by their parents/guardians. If 30 minutes or more of camp on any given day has been completed, it will be considered a complete hour. If we are not able to conduct camp hours because of weather-related cancellations, we will make every attempt to make up those hours.

CAMPER INFO: Campers should arrive 15 minutes prior to the start of each session, dressed and ready to play. Soccer players are also expected to bring their inflated camp ball, cleats, shin guards, soccer socks and any other soccer equipment they might need. Also be sure to bring water.
